

SCRIPT FOR THE ONSLOW ARC ARES WEEKLY NET

Is this frequency in use?.....

Calling the Onslow ARC ARES Net this is **(your callsign)** and my name is **(your name)**.....pause

The purpose of this net is to provide a media for training, exchange of ideas, and information concerning the local amateur radio community and the Amateur Radio Emergency Service. We always invite and encourage visitors to join the net.....pause

This net meets each Thursday night at 8:00 PM local time on the 147.000 repeater. In the event the repeater goes down, the net will switch to the 145.190 repeater, and both of repeaters have a negative offset with an 88.5pl tone.....pause

For the purpose of training and/or in the event Net Control drops out, I request a station copy the formal portion of this net. Volunteers please call **(your callsign)** Net Control....pause

Do we have any stations with EMERGENCY or PRIORITY traffic, if so, please call now.....pause

Stations are asked to check into the net according to the first letter of your call sign suffix; Please give your full Call Sign, Name, Location, and List any Traffic or announcements you may have for the net.....

Do we have any Mobile or Portable stations? If so, please call now.....pause

Do we have any stations on frequency connected via Echolink? If so, please call now.....pause

Stations ALPHA through GOLF.....pause

Stations HOTEL through NOVEMBER.....pause

Stations OSCAR through TANGO.....pause

Stations UNIFORM through ZULU.....pause

Any station ALPHA through ZULU wishing to check into the Onslow ARC ARES Net, please call now.....pause

Are there any stations with net announcements, business or bulletins, not already listed, please call now.....pause

{Handle net announcements in the order of check-in and announcement request}

Are there any questions about net announcements?.....pause

Any late stations to check into the Onslow ARC ARES Net, please call **(your callsign)**, Net Control.....pause

This is **(your callsign)** now closing the formal portion of the Onslow ARC ARES Net and we will continue with an informal portion. Thank you to the **(copying station's call)** for copying along....

{If the calendar date is even start at the top of the list and work down. If the calendar date is odd start at the bottom of the list and work up. Work mobile, portable and EchoLink stations first if possible.}

This now concludes the Onslow ARC ARES Net. We thank all members and visitors who checked in as well as others who kept this frequency clear so we could conduct our net. This is **(your callsign)** now returning the **(147.000)** repeater to normal Amateur use. **(your callsign) OUT....**
